Student Guidelines and Behavior Department

Effective learning cannot occur without an approach to student behavior that stresses self-discipline, self-reliance and respect. Student discipline should reflect the school's policy of non-violence that creates an atmosphere that is favorable to concentration, attention and creativity. Students will be successful at Northside Preparatory Academy by knowing and obeying the rules and accepting responsibility for their behavior.

Students of Northside Preparatory Academy are expected to:

1. Come to school on time ready to learn in complete uniform each day.
2. Follow school and classrooms rules and routines as established by the school Principal and teacher(s). Accept feedback without talkback.
3. Help maintain a safe school environment.
4. Taking responsibility for one's choices and actions.
5. Respect others by not bullying, teasing, name calling, or making unkind remarks.
6. Respect the rights of others property and belongings and not infringe on others personal space.
7. Show respect for all teachers and other members of the school community.
8. Take responsibility for having learning materials and complete assignments each day to include homework.
9. Keep the classroom and work areas organized and clean.
10. Follow directions the first time given and make good use of time.
11. Know school is a place of learning and must be treated as such, not infringing on others right to learn allowing ALL to enjoy their time in class.
12. Ask for permission from the teacher before leaving the classroom or others areas of the building.
13. Live up to the Northside Preparatory Academy School Creed and Mission.

General Rules of Expectation:

1. Use quiet (Level 0), conversational voices while in the classroom and hallway areas of the building.
2. Take good care of textbooks, learning materials and technology equipment.
3. Not bring to school dangerous or disruptive items or replicas of dangerous or disruptive items. Toys and electronically devices should not be brought to school.
4. Cell phone use at school is prohibited. Cell phones will be collected daily and stored securely. Cell phones that have to be confiscated from a student must be picked up by a parent or guardian.

5. A student may not write or draw on school property.
6. Follow the uniform dress code. Wear the school uniform with pride.
7. Keep hands and feet to oneself, not throwing objects, hitting, kicking or doing anything to endanger another student or teacher's safety.
8. Show respect to all adults and follow directions willingly and promptly.
