Dublin Preparatory Academy d.b.a Northside Preparatory Academy is committed to providing a school environment that promotes and protects students' health, well-being, and ability to learn by supporting healthy eating, social and emotional health and physical health. Student Wellness and Success funds will be used to provide mental and behavioral health services, occupational and physical therapy, healthy living programs and other health services associated with serving students within the school community.

NPA will use at least 50% of the SWSF for mental health services or physical health services or a combination while working with outside agencies to provide counseling and behavioral health supports and school-based mental health professional and other services to support students within the school community.

To support the use of SWSF, the school will partner with at least two community partners to provide support services. During the 2024-25 school year, the school will partner with Kids Thrive(EK-4th) and Wilken Development and Behavioral Services(5th-8th) (i.e. a community mental health prevention or treatment provider or local board of alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services board and one of the community partners listed on the SWSF and Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aid webpage) and Therapy Source and Comprehensive Concepts, to support students physical needs(serving students with disabilities) and assistance to students with limited language needs (ELL students).

The use of the SWSF will impact our students by improving overall Social and Emotional Health and addressing the ongoing needs and concerns associated with the 2020 pandemic. The SWSF will help 15-20% of students who will be directly impacted. The school expects to see a 5-10% decrease in disruptive student behavior year after year.
